WHEREAS, Arizona's children deserve quality early care and education environments that build their skills as lifelong learners; and

WHEREAS, Nurturing parenting and quality child care and early learning programs are essential to children's development during the critical years from birth to age five; and

WHEREAS, Access to reliable, quality child care and early learning opportunities makes it possible for more Arizonans to be able to work and pursue higher education; and

WHEREAS, Access to quality child care and early learning contributes to strong families and businesses, a thriving state economy, and vibrant communities; and

WHEREAS, First Things First, Arizona Association for the Education of Young Children, Southern Arizona Association for the Education of Young Children, and other community organizations, in conjunction with the National Association for the Education of Young Children, are celebrating the 53rd anniversary of the Week of the Young Child; and

WHEREAS, These organizations are working to improve equitable early learning opportunities that provide a strong start for children birth to age five across the Grand Canyon State; and

WHEREAS, the child care workforce, early childhood educators, and others who care for and teach young children deserve to be recognized and supported for their essential work.
